The birth of the Lions Club of Urbino... ...told by Carlo Bo

"Many years ago (now I see they're forty) a man from Switzerland came to visit me because he wanted to found a Lions Club in Urbino. In that period the idea seemed impossible to me due to the very conservative and exclusive nature of the association. But after his persistence I accepted the invitation and called Dr. Leonardo Paloscia, who was Chief Administrator at the University, and Prof. Piacesi who both have the merit of founding the Lions Club of Urbino. I was wrong, the Lions Club had great success and it is still active and useful for the social life of the town, which today is very different from how it was in the '50s. L'AQUILONE [THE KITE]

Giovanni Pascoli, (1855-1912)

" [...] Or siam fermi; abbiamo in faccia Urbino ventoso: ognuno manda da una balza una cometa per il ciel turchino. [...]"

The poem "L'Aquilone" (The Kite), from which these lines are taken, was written by Giovanni Pascoli in order to remember the time spent in Urbino as a student of the Collegio degli Scolopi. He entered the school when he was seven, in 1862, together with his brothers Giacomo and Luigi. He had been living there until 1871, when he finished the first year of secondary school.

During the Festa dell'Aquilone (Kite Festival) the Contrade of Urbino confront each other in a contest, which consists of making their kite reach the highest point in the sky. This event has always been important for people living in Urbino. Everybody, since childhood, has made kites and launched them into the sky. So, to make a kite is an important tradition in Urbino where it is done in the classical way, using waxed paper, giant cane, wheatpaste and a big amount of fantasy.

Therefore, the Members of Lions Club of Urbino invite you to the 61st edition of the traditional and colorful **Festa dell'Aquilone (Kite Festival)**, taking pace in **September, 3-4, 2016** in a field a few kilometers from the city centre, among the **hills of Cesane**, where hundreds of kites will fly in the sky on the background of *"windy Urbino"*.
