For the attendants: short guided tour to "II Mitreo del Circo Massimo" (to be confirmed to the organizing committee) a place destined for mystery rites of the god Mithras, Babylonian Iranian deity whose cult found its maximum diffusion in the Roman Empire, between III and IV centuries A.D. The central act of the myth is the killing of the cosmic bull that, dying, creates the universe. Back at about 13.

A guided tour to "**Diocleziano's baths**" (to be confirmed to the organizing committee) the most marvellous thermal complex ever built in the Roman world. Built between 298 and 306 A.D., the Baths were transformed by Michelangelo who realized there the Basilica of Santa Maria degli Angeli e dei Martiri Cristiani and la Certosa.
